Associate professor of Ancient History at the University of Athens, 1989-2000. Professor of Ancient History at the University of Athens, 2000-.

Head of the Department of History and Archaeology (2005-2007, 2009-2011). Deputy Head of the Saripolos Foundation of the University of Athens (2007-). Vice-Rector of the University of Athens on Academic Affairs and International Relations (2014-).

Visiting member of the Institute for Advanced Study (Princeton), academic year 1996-7. Visiting professor of the University of Cyprus (February 2007).
