Professor **Hagen Fleischer\*** teaches Contemporary History at the University of Athens (since September 2011 as emeritus).

Fleischer has written more than 100 scholarly publications, mostly on contemporary Greek History and the World War II era and its legacy. Most recent book (in Greek): *The Wars of Memory: WW II in Public History* [4<sup>th</sup> edition: Athens 2012]. For more titles see the **selective list in the Greek version of this link**.
